



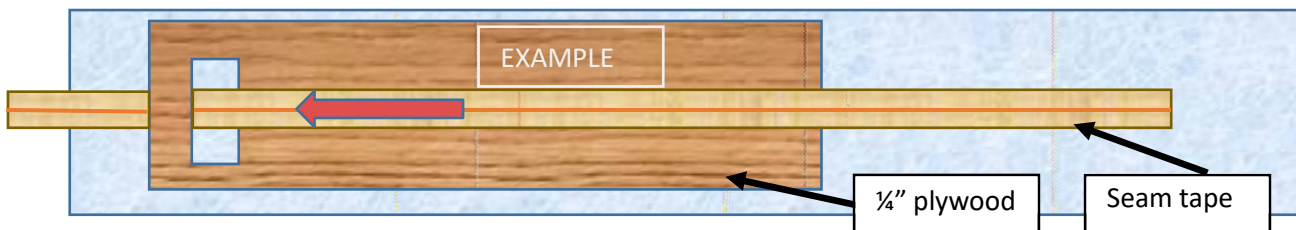
## Subject: Flex-Back / Comfort-Back Carpeting

Date: August 19<sup>th</sup>, 2020 Features and Benefits:

- Reduces Wrinkles
- Reduces Re-stretching (when properly installed)
- Minimizes interior scuffs and scratches (normally found with synthetic jute backed carpet)
- Increased elasticity for better stretch and recovery
- Helps prevent delamination
- Resistance to seam peaking as well as superior seam pull strength (see recommendation)
- Easier to work with during cold climate
- Enhanced sound absorption and insulation

Seam construction was greatly improved constructing the seam over a hard surface placed between the padding and carpet.

Seam board will slide in the direction of the arrow as the seam is made



Using a smooth seam roller while placing the carpet into the seaming tape will provide better penetration for the thermo plastic of the tape. Economy seaming tapes are not recommended. Like all broadloom carpet, the seams require proper sealing using a latex seam sealer.

Proper power stretching per CRI 105 Residential Installation Guidelines is required.
